## What is European Research Council?




The ERC supports excellence in frontier research through a bottom-up, individual-based, pan-European competition



# \_egislation

Scientific governance: independent Scientific Council with 22 members including the ERC President; full authority over funding strategy

- ➤ Support by the ERC Executive Agency (autonomous)
- > Excellence as the only criterion





- ➤ Support for the individual scientist
- ➤ Global peer-review
- No predetermined subjects (bottom-up)
- Support of frontier research in all fields of science and humanities



### ERC grant schemes and tentative call schedule 2021

## Starting Grants Call deadine 8.4.2021

- > PI 2-7 years after PhD
- > Up to 1.5 (2.5) M€
- Up to 5 years

#### **Consolidator Grants**

Call deadline 20.4.2021

- 7-12 years after PhD
- > Up to 2 (3.0) M€
- Up to 5 years

### **Advanced Grants**

**Call deadline 31.8.2021** 

- 10-year track-record of significant achievements\*
- ➤ Up to 2.5 (3.5) M€
- Up to 5 years

\*No specific eligibility criteria

#### **Proof-of-Concept**

Earliest stage of marketable innovation

€150,000 for ERC grant holders

Not included in WP 2021


#### **Synergy Grants**

Jointly for 2-4 principal investigators
Up to 10 (14) M€, 6 years



### Researchers career and complementary funding schemes




## Number of grants - H2020 StG-CoG-AdG (except AdG-2020)






## Number of grants per 1M people - H2020 StG-CoG-AdG (except AdG-2020)




## ERCs to Finland – share of funding and number of grants (H2020, except AdG-2020)

**Total funding: 209 M€** 


#### **Number of grants to Finland**





## The role of the Academy in applying for ERC funding

- The Academy of Finland acts as national contact organization for Horizon Europe together with Business Finland. The programme committee and National Contact Point (NCP) responsibilities are divided between the Academy and Business Finland.
- For all funding schemes, NCPs have been appointed to assist and advise applicants and their Host Institutions (HI). At the Academy, two science advisers dedicate part of their working time for ERC NCP activities.
- NCPs and the committee member participate in the programme and the ERC meetings (in Brussels or remotely) and distribute information to the Research Services of the HIs in Finland.
- NCPs have arranged twice a year interview training for second-stage StG and CoG
  applicants together with external ERC-consultants. With the applicant, one person from
  the Research services of the HI has usually participated in the training.
