AI Based Legal Decision-making from the Lawmakers' Point of View

Abstract:

The presentation is about “AI Based Legal Decision-making from the Lawmakers’ Point of View”, or rather Legal AI. The understanding of AI is broad, oriented towards the legal domain emphasizing core values such as the principle of legality, the notion of privacy with some reflections about trust in the digital information society. A major point is that transparency is a condition for privacy in the context of personal data processing based on AI methods. However, applications may be governed by principles of openness but still not provide transparency due to lack of access rights and (how) they are implemented. In terms of ways forward the following aspects are briefly commented on: customised principle of openness, regulatory sandboxes, enabling legal system management, proactive law, innovative law, remedies when things go wrong, enhanced role of ethics, and the rule of law 2.0.
