"Not good enough for everyone". Finding space for Sámi education in a diverse Sámi community

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In this presentation, I look into the situation for educators working within or connected to field of Sámi education. I take as a starting point the encounters between the demands of the national curricula on one hand, the demands from the local authorities and the Sámi parliament on the other, and the local situation of schools and ECE institutions on the third. The empirical basis is a set of research conversations had with leadership in municipalities and educational institutions. They have in common an explicit responsibility for Sámi education. I lean on previous analyses of Sámi issues in curricula as well as on presentations of the respective local contexts.
