HOW TO JOIN THE UNITWIN/UNESCO NETWORK ON TEACHER EDUCATION FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND DIVERSITY IN EDUCATION

The purpose of the UNITWIN/UNESCO Network on Teacher Education for Social Justice and Diversity in Education is to promote teacher education practices especially in the fields of inclusive education, education for long distances and indigenous education. The Network will develop North-South collaboration and aims to create long-term partnerships. The Network is led by University of Lapland, Finland.

The Network is free to join. No funding will be received from the Network or UNESCO. The member institutions are encouraged to identify funding resources to promote their participation in network activities.

The possible new member University or Institution needs to sign the Memorandum of Understanding. By UNESCO regulations, it is required that the MoU is signed by the Rector/Vice Chancellor of the University or a respective person of the Institution. The MoUs will be reviewed and accepted in the administrative meetings of the Network organised biannually. All current members of the Network need to accept the applications. All Network activities (except administrative meetings) are open for all interested bodies.
