Search versus Re-search.

ABSTRACT

After the end of the mapping activity with the survey about research, which was carried out within the associated Cumulus schools, the working group aims to focus on the shift of visions and perspectives about the categories of research in Art and Design.

The title of the WG, Search versus Research, as the famous collection of lectures held in Yale (1969) by Joseph Albers, is intended to bring our attention about the activity of research as an activity concerned with the concept of new. Nevertheless, the concept of humanities researches as discovering new perspectives, or new information, is actually a very recent formulation, especially if we want to apply the word research to the discipline of art and design. Starting from the well-known three categories of research by Christopher Frayling (1993) Research about Design/Research through Design/Research for Design, the working group in Rovaniemi is starting a debate about these definitions, in order to forecast new visions on research.
