- Non-EU students apply for residence permit. Check the box "population register and Personal identity" code in your permit application. More info: www.migri.fi
- Take an insurance.
- Organize finances, credit card & bank account.
- Reserve enough cash for the beginning of your stay.
- Contact your tutor.
- Join our Facebook groups. Book your travel to Rovaniemi.



- Meet your tutor.
- Settle down and check if you have everything you need.
- Make your adventure to the nearest grocery store.
- Reserve cash to join the Student Union (LYY) not compulsory, but highly recommended.
- Participate in the Orientation program. Take your ID and Insurance policy along.
- EU, Swiss and Lichtenstein citizens: Register your right to reside in Finland in Migri.fi or at the local register office. Apply also for the Finnish Personal Identity Code with it.
- Nordic citizens: Register your residence in Finland and apply for a Personal Identity Code at a local register office.
- Download TUUDO app.
- Get familiar with WebOodi.
- Make friends and mingle.

First weeks

- Visit Student Services to inform your Finnish Personal I dentity Code.
- Download Frankapp via Frank.fi (register with Identity Code).
- Pay the first month's rent.
- Apply for a library card.
- Fix all possible problems with mobile phone and internet connection
- Open a bank account if necessary.
- Locate the Health Care Services.
- Get to know the local student associations like LYY and ESN.
- Consider getting a bike.
- Beware of thin ice on river. Don't walk on it unless you see locals do it first.
